Counseling and Student Personal Master's Programs

In 2023, approximately 75 students were enrolled in the Counseling and Student Personnel CACREP Accredited Master's Programs. Approximately 75% of those students enrolled are women, approximately 25% of those students enrolled are men, and approximately 0% are alternate gender. The Counseling and Student Personnel (CSP) programs are competitive and 48% of the candidates that had completed an application for the 2023-2024 academic year were accepted into their selected program. One hundred percent of accepted students graduate in the expected time period, which is two years for full-time students and three years for part-time students. Courses accommodate both part-time and full-time students.
