Bachelor of Science Teaching degree, (2) all required testing (if needed), and (3) submitted application for
license. (Candidates selected for this program must submit a copy of their Minnesota license as proof of
eligibility to begin the Graduate Teaching Fellowship before by August 2024.)

Candidates may apply for the Fellowship program and accept offers while their application for MN teacher licensure is in process/pending [in process/pending = candidates will have successfully earned a degree from an accredited teacher preparation program and will have been recommended for licensure.] NOTE=Candidates who answer "Yes" to any question on the Conduct Review Statement within the license application may experience delays in receiving their licensure.
