## Essay Writing Sample

To better understand your research interests, educational aspirations, and academic writing skills, we ask you to submit one two-part essay in response to both prompts. Your work must meet the following requirements:

- Your essay must be 1000 words or fewer, double-spaced, with 1-inch margins, and 12-point Times New Roman font.
- Include a cover page with a title and your name.
- Use at least three in-text citations in the body of your essay to support your claims.
- Provide a reference page with at least three recent articles or books to verify your in-text citations.
- The cover and reference pages are not counted toward your 1000-word maximum.

## Questions for Essay Writing Sample

Please address the following two questions in your essay.

### **Part 1:**

What question or topic might you research that demonstrates the intersection of education, leadership, and racial equity, and why?

### **Part 2:**

In your personal and/or professional life, what have you done to educate yourself and/or address predictable racial disparities?
