Student Teaching Application Deadline

Wednesday, October 23 by 4pm



Application Requirements

- You are required to submit your application by Wednesday,
 October 23rd at 4:00 pm
- Placement conversations (October 30 to November 7)
 - You will receive an email to sign up for a time that works for you
 - One-on-one conversations
 - Must complete Student Teaching Applications



Prerequisites for Student Teaching

- Complete all course requirements prior to starting student teaching
- Signed Verification Form from your advisor
- Meet the GPA requirements of your program
 - 3.0 in all ELE courses





Placement Guidelines

- Clinical experiences (field experiences, including student teaching)
 are vital to the MSU Mankato teacher preparation program.
 - Put the theory from coursework into practice
 - Each experience is thoughtfully selected to allow pre-service teachers exposure to a variety of grade levels, schools and cooperating teachers
 - Work with students who differ in race, ethnicity, home language, socioeconomic status and with a range of exceptionalities

Requirements

- Annually complete background check
- Obtain liability insurance
- Ability to travel to school partner sites
 - MSU, Mankato does not provide transportation to school sites or guarantee that specific location requests can be accommodated





ELE Placement Guidelines

- Candidates may not attempt to secure their own placement
- Yearlong placements
 - You will likely be in the same classroom for both semesters
- Indicate and commit to which campus you plan to complete Block III and Student Teaching
- We will arrange placements within 60 minutes from either Edina or Mankato campus, based on normal traffic patterns



We prioritize placements based on:

- Minnesota Education Partnership (MEP) sites
- Quality of placement
- Licensure requirements
- Availability of qualified school/mentor teacher





Things to Remember

- Plan ahead
 - Travel
 - Work schedules
 - Extra-curricular activities
- Save the date Student Teaching Orientation!
 - Attendance is required 2nd or 3rd week of August (watch your MNSU email)
 - Orientation runs the entire day
- For initial licensure, you are required to student teach for the entire semester
 - If your goal is to add additional licenses, plan to extend your student teaching experience

 - This will help guide the reader
- Keep each response to one or two paragraphs (but more than 1 or 2 sentences)
- Clarity of thought and mechanics are important
 - Have other people read and proofread your work
- Be thoughtful and maintain a positive tone throughout your responses
